ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENTS

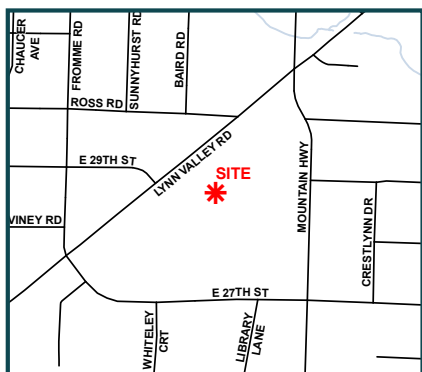
When: Tuesday, February 7, 2023 at 7pm

What: A Public Hearing for Bylaw 8607, an amendment to the Zoning bylaw to allow "Cannabis Retail Store" as a permitted use for the property located at 124 – 1199 Lynn Valley Road in the Lynn Valley Town Centre.

What Changes: Bylaw 8607 proposes to amend the Zoning Bylaw to add the property located at 124 – 1199 Lynn Valley Road to the table of properties where a Cannabis Retail Store may be located.
